Sexually Transmitted Diseases Overview Expedited Partner Therapy (EPT) is the clinical practice of treating the sex partners of patients diagnosed with chlamydia, gonorrhea, or both by providing prescriptions or medications to the patient to take to his or her partner(s) without the health care provider first examining the partner(s)
